General Information

- **Entry:** The official entry form must be accurately completed and include the \$25.00 entry fee. Wrestlers that qualify for state **MUST REGISTER FOR THE STATE TOURNAMENT** at the Regional Tournament Site the day of the regional tournament. Athletes **WILL NOT** be allowed to switch weight classes.
- **Eligibility:** All athletes who meet age requirements, and who are current members of USA Wrestling are eligible. Proof of current USA Wrestling membership must be witnessed at registration. Secondary sports accident insurance is provided as a benefit of membership. Top four (4) place winners from each Regional Tournament qualify for State. Spots not filled will move on to next qualifier.
- **Weigh-ins:** weigh-ins will be in the West Gym across the street from the UNI Dome at the University of Northern Iowa. **Weigh-ins will be held Saturday March 6th from 2:00 to 3:30 pm. There is NO scale allowance. There Will Be A Check Scale On Site. Must wear singlet when weighing in.**
- **Rules:** National Federation of State High School Association scoring rules will govern the competition, unless otherwise indicated on this form. USA Wrestling rules governing ages, weights, and match time will take precedence when applicable.
- **Uniforms:** Singlets required. Head gear is required.
- **Match Length:** In accordance with USA Wrestling kids division. Novice and Schoolboy/girl matches are 1-1.5-1.5 minute periods. Bantams and Intermediate matches 1-1-1 minute periods.

- **Pairings:** Top 2 place winners from each regional qualifier will be paired opposite sides of brackets the rest will be separated as best as possible. Double elimination line brackets with complete wrestle back to 3rd place.
- **Coaching:** Minimum Copper Certification Required to coach in corner. Wristbands will be issued free of charge to copper certified coaches with **current USA Wrestling Coaches Card**. There will be a Copper Certification Clinic on Saturday at 4:00 pm. in the Panther room located in the NE corner in side the UNI Dome. **There will be no coaches cards sold at State. Must go on line and purchased ahead of time at *themat.com*.**
- **Floor Passes:** will be sold to anyone wishing to go on floor to escort wrestlers and take pictures for \$5.00
- **Medical Information:** Athletes must be prepared and submit to a skin disease screening prior to weigh-in. The Chief medical officer has full authority without appeal in determining the eligibility of an athlete to compete. IN the event of injury or illness, no contestant will be permitted to continue the competition without approval of the Chief Medical Officer, whose decision is final and not subject to appeal.
- **Individual awards:** IWF Medals will be awarded to top six place winners in each weight class.
- **Team Trophy at State.** Must be a USA Chartered Club. All wrestlers must be registered to a USA Chartered Club to compete for that Club at State. Club Name with Club Rosters must be emailed to the IWF Membership Director Denna Massey. Djcm19273@yahoo.com. Send name of club and rosters prior to Feb. 27th, 2010.
- **National Team:** You will receive registration information at state. All wrestlers that compete at State are eligible for Nationals.
- **Admissions:** Adults: \$7.00, Students K-12: \$4.00, Preschool: free
